

We demonstrate this commitment through the implementation of safety and security management, surveys and reporting, and the provision of appropriate safety training for employees, contracted personnel and third party persons. We continually implement improvements to Occupational Safety in the processes for design, construction, delivery, and repair of FPSOs and other contracted products and services.

By means of target setting, awareness, and training combined with monitoring, we aim to continuously improve the safety of our employees and the Occupational Safety performance.

This is achieved by:

- Management commitment to safety and security throughout the organization
- Employee involvement, consultation and cooperation to ensure a safe workplace
- Promotion of a secure environment by driving a strong safety culture and a secure environment and ensuring all employees share the commitment to this goal
- Compliance with the principles of OHSAS 18001, ISPS and ISM
- Complying with or exceeding applicable occupational health laws and regulations
- Accountability and responsibility for safety of all personnel
- Target settings and monitoring of performance to achieve continuous improvement
- Encouraging employees to freely report ways and means to improve our overall safety performance
- “Target zero” principles for LTI and active learning from reported incidents
- Measurement and benchmarking of performance internally and against industry standards
- Systematic identification of risks and hazards in accordance with risk management procedures
- Encouragement of the integration of safety considerations into business planning and decisions, including design, production and facilities management.
